

Food supply for elderly people

Almost every elderly in Chet has to face poverty. Those who have children with a stable financial background are in a better situation. Those without any support from their relatives have to struggle for an acceptable condition, trying to manage themselves from their very low pensions which would not reach in lots of the situations 100-150 EUR. Our brothers from Hardinxveldt are deeply involved in helping 25 elderly people to receive warm meal twice a week, bringing hope in their desperate situation. This program involves one employed diaconal worker and several volunteers in order to cook for them on Tuesday and Thursday of every week.

Rural poverty is practically nonexistent in the European Union (EU) and in Northern Europe



but it is a growing threat to people in rural areas in Eastern Europe and parts of Southern Europe. In those regions, after the collapse of the Soviet Union, many countries are still going through a difficult economic, social and political transition. In the context of rural poverty, Europe is a continent of sharp

contrasts. While poverty in parts of Eastern and Southern Europe is on the rise, human development indicators confirm that living conditions in all of the EU countries are among the best in the world.

One out of five Europeans — 93 million people — lives under the poverty line. The poor include



and a good vision for future. This is why our strategy focus on kids education and evangelism, creating thus the possibility of overgrowing bad family impact in time. The program is drawing in 50-80 children between age 7-11 who are cherished by a staff of 11, 9 teachers, 1 evangelization teacher, and 1 music teacher, being organized in 5 groups. The children are helped in their homeworks, their social and spiritual skills are developed.

2014 in numbers

- 25 elderly people involved in the Food supply program, with an annual budget of 6000 Euros, resulting in 2.26 Euros per meal for one person. Around 3-4000 Euros are paid above this for the salary of 1 diaconal worker. Several volunteers are involved too, in order to give a bigger effectiveness to the work. Cloth supplies given by the Reformed Community of Hardinxveldt increase our capacity and gives an enormous support for us.
- 84 kids involved in Eutichos educational program, with an annual budget of 33 050 EUR of which 21753 EUR is for food and accommodation (2.25 EUR per person), 8942 EUR is for salaries 2059 EUR is for maintenance and 296 is for several accessories. The average attendance of the kids is 66,6 per cent, which means that 56 of the 84 involved in the program attend the activities on a regular basis. Main supporter is Foundation Van den Heerik.
- more than 300 youngsters are involved in our youth-ministry, around 40 localy while the others from the region. We don't have a fix budget for this, although this is a main stream of our work. But God is a Great Provider, and we believe He will never let us down.

rural people in Central and Eastern Europe and ethnic minorities such as the Roma, who are among the poorest people in Europe. The Roma comprise almost 40 per cent of poor people in Romania.
